WINTER CAMP - FAQ

1) Who is camp for?

We offer camp for 5 – 12 year olds.

2) What are the dates of camp?

Camp will be offered during the following weeks:

<u>Session 1</u>: December 26 – December 20, 2023 <u>Session 2</u>: January 2 – January 5, 2024

Camp will run from 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM Monday through Thursday and 9:00 AM - 2:00 PM on Friday.

Before care is available from 8:00 AM – 9:00 AM, for \$25 per week.

3) What is the price of camp?

For Y Members \$195 per week / For non-members \$230 per week.

Subsidies are available upon request and need.

4) What does an average day at camp look like? What activities will be offered at camp?

Throughout the day, campers will swim in our pool, create art projects, practice sports and cooperative play. There will also be time spent every day outside in the wonderful park across the street.

5) Will there be Jewish content in camp?

The Y City Camp is open to all, regardless of religion or religious observance. There will be opportunities for Jewish related programming in camp such as Shabbat on Fridays, crafts, and stories.

6) <u>Where will camp be held?</u>

Camp will be held at Sylvan Adams YM-YWHA, 5400 Westbury Ave, Montreal, Quebec H3W 2W8.

7) What is the counselor / camper ratio?

Bunks will have approximately 10 - 15 campers to every 2 staff. We take careful consideration in placing our **staff according to their strengths and friendships with our campers.**

8) Are you a nut free camp?

Yes! We do not allow nuts to come to camp in lunches or snacks.

9) Will you be going outside in the winter?

Yes! We prioritize outdoor play in every weather. Please expect that campers will go outside every day unless there is a weather advisory or extreme cold and we deem it unsafe to do so. Pack and dress campers accordingly!
