General Responsibilities:

- Assist senior counselor and other camp staff members as they plan and oversee activities;
- Supervise the campers in your group at all times, and must know where they are at all times;
- Develop positive relationships, act as a role model and maintains a high level of motivation and enthusiasm with your campers;
- Go into the water on a daily basis;
- Ensure that the camp and surrounding area are clean;
- Ensure that any equipment used is correctly stored after every activity;
- Responsible for designing and leading programs, ice-breaker games, special activities.

Qualifications:

- Need to have completed Grade 10 on the day camp start date;
- Enthusiastic about working with youth;
- Ability to swim;
- Good communicator, approachable and patient;
- Able to create a safe space where all campers feel that they are welcomed and valued;
- Able to assist in creating, facilitating and leading activities in a creative and organized manner;
- Able to work in a team setting;
- Able to adapt themselves to the needs of the campers;
- Have a working knowledge of Israel including; sports, culinary arts, music, arts, geography, history, demographics. Accepts multiple narratives.
- Bilingualism (French and English); Knowledge of the Hebrew language a plus.
